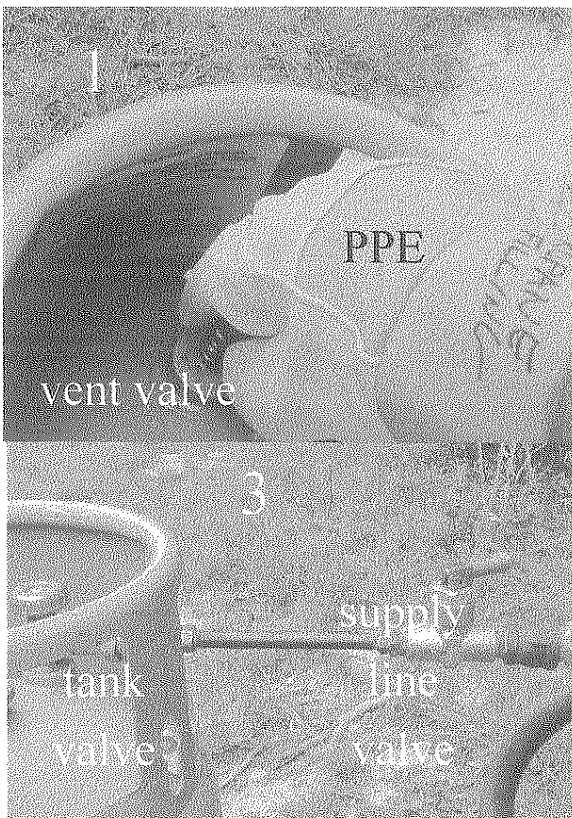


Propane tank filling

1. put on PPE (leather or rubber gloves, & glasses) [figure 1]
2. put tank on scale (fill by weight*) [figure 2]
3. attach fill line from supply tank to portable tank [figure 3]
4. open supply tank main valve... and, in this order:
 5. open valve on top of portable tank
 6. open vent/bleed valve on portable tank [figure 1]
 7. open supply hose valve [figure 3]
8. when the tank becomes full, propane 'mist' will spew out of the vent valve [figure 4]. Promptly, in this order:
 9. close supply hose valve
 10. close vent/bleed valve
 11. close portable tank valve
12. slowly disconnect supply line from tank, carefully venting pressure.



*Note: When filling a '20 lb' tank, the liquid (mist) will spew out when the tank is full. A full tank (disconnected from the supply line) will show ~43 lbs; the recommended weight for this tank. While the tank is filling on the scale the reading may be slightly off due to the weight of the filling hose. Check weight the tank.
