Caution: Risk of crushing!

Storage location: Bolt A with split pin

2. Checking the fuel supply Page 80

Caution: Risk of fire!

Fuel specification: Diesel (EN 590)



3. Checking the engine oil level re Page 80

Caution: Risk of scalding! Engine oil specification: API CJ-4

e.g.: Titan Cargo 5W-40



4. Checking the hydraulic oil level r Page 81

Caution: Risk of crushing!

Hydraulic oil specification: HVLP 46

e.g.: Mobiloil DTE 10 Excel





5. Checking the coolant level 🔊 Page 81

Caution: Risk of scalding! Coolant specification: G12 e.g.: Total Glaceelf Auto Supra



6. Checking the tyre pressure № Page 81

Standard tyres 23x8.5-12TT 10PR T539:

front/rear: 1.9 bar / 2.7 bar



Driving with the Citymaster 650




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1. Preparing for driving Page 84

Move the accelerator pedals **36/37** to the neutral position.

Actuate the brake pedal **46** or the parking brake **45**. Warning light **A** lights up. Fasten the seat belt!



3. Starting transport mode


Release the parking brake 45. Warning light A off.

Use the accelerator pedal 36/37 to select the driving

direction.

2. Starting the engine re Page 85

Use the ignition switch **76** to preheat the engine. Start the engine once the telltale **B** goes out. Observe the warning symbols! № Page 49



4. Parking the vehicle r Page 90


Move the accelerator pedal back to the neutral position. Lock the parking brake **45**. Warning light **A** on.



4. Switching vacuum sweeping on № Page 135


Press the Hako button **71**. All set sweeping functions are switched on.

Work mode information symbol A lights up.



6. Starting vacuum sweeping Page 136

Slowly press down the accelerator pedal **36**. Vehicle speed depending on the engine fixed speed: ECO = 16 km/h, standard = 20 km/h, maximum = 27 km/h



8. Changing the sweeping width re Page 137

Press the joystick **70** to the left/right: The rotating brush swivels to the left/right.

9. Sweeping dry/wet surfaces Page 142

Circulating water is supplied to bind dust.

If necessary, switch on the fresh water pump.


Use the lever **B** to adjust the fresh water quantity.

5. Selecting the engine fixed speed re Page 136

Tip switch **64** stage 1: ECO – low sweeping power.


Stage 2: Standard – medium sweeping power.

Stage 3: Maximum - high sweeping power.



7. Sweeping larger objects 🕸 Page 137

Press the pedal **47**: The coarse material flap opens. Move the pedal to the right: Pedal engages. Move the pedal to the left: Pedal disengages.



10. Operating the multifunction display № Page 35

The turn-push knob **69** is used to select menus and submenus and to set values.

Settings during vacuum sweeping:

Setting the rotating brush speed **C** № Page 141 Switching the fresh water pump on **D** № Page 142 Switching the suction fan on **E** № Page 142
