

# FOR COMMERCIAL USE ONLY IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When using an electrical appliance, basic precautions should always be followed, including the following:

#### READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USING

WARNING - To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury:

 Do not leave appliance when plugged in. Unplug from outlet when not in use and before servicing.

#### WARNING

To avoid electric shock, use indoors only.

- Do not allow to be used as a toy. Close attention is necessary when used by or near children.
- Use only as described in this manual. Use only manufacturer's recommended attachments.
- Do not use with damaged cord or plug. If appliance is not working as it should, has been dropped, damaged, left outdoors, or dropped into water, return it to a service center.
- Do not pull or carry by cord, use cord as a handle, close a door on cord, or pull cord around sharp edges or corners. Do not run appliance over cord. Keep cord away from heated surfaces.
- Do not unplug by pulling on cord. To unplug, grasp the plug, not the cord.
- Do not handle plug or appliance with wet hands.
- Do not put any object into openings. Do not use with any opening blocked; keep free of dust, lint, hair, and anything that may reduce air flow.
- Keep hair, loose clothing, fingers, and all parts of body away from openings and moving parts.
- Do not pick up anything that is burning or smoking, such as cigarettes, matches, or hot ashes.
- Do not use without dustbag and/or filters in place.
- Turn off all controls before unplugging.
- · Use extra care when cleaning on stairs.
- Do not use to pick up flammable or combustible liquids such as gasoline or use in areas where they may be present.
- Connect to a properly grounded outlet only. See grounding instructions.

# INSPECTION

Carefully unpack and inspect your floor machine for shipping damage. Each unit is tested and thoroughly inspected before shipment and any damage is the responsibility of the delivering carrier who should be notified immediately. Read all instruction carefully before operating.

### WARNING

Electric shock could occur if used outdoors or on wet surfaces.

Electrical motors can cause explosions when operating near explosive materials or vapors. Do not operate this machine near flammable materials such as solvents, thinners, fuels, grain dust, etc.

#### **ELECTRICAL**


This machine is designed to operate on a standard 15 amp. 115 volt, 60 hz, AC circuit. Voltages below 105 volts AC or above 125 volts AC could cause serious damage to the motor.

## GROUNDING INSTRUCTIONS

To protect the operator from electrical shock, this machine must be grounded while in use. This machine is equipped with an approved three-conductor power cord and grounding type plug to fit the proper grounding type receptacle.

This machine is for use on a nominal 120 volt circuit and has a grounding type plug that looks like the plug illustrated in Sketch A. Make sure that the machine is connected to an outlet having the same configuration as the plug. No adapter should be used with this machine.

For equipment rated 150-250 volts: If the machine is provided with an attachment plug as shown in Sketch B, it is intended for use on a 240 volt (nominal) circuit. No adapter is available for this plug.



# **EXTENSION CORDS**

If an extension cord is used, the wire size must be at least one size larger than the power cord on the machine and must be limited to 25 feet in length. Extension cord must be three-wire grounded.

# **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

Your upright vacuum is equipped with a 54" pull-out hose for cleaning remote areas such as ash trays, desk tops, window sills, etc. The cuff may be used alone or with 1 1/2" attachments.

To use, pull out hose, grasp cuff, lift up out of hose seat and pull hose down through grommet opening located in lower rear of tank. Turn vacuum switch on. Fig. I.

To replace hose, with vacuum on, grasp cuff in one hand while covering opening with the other. This action permits the hose to contract while being drawn back into the tank. NOTE: Hose may have to be guided through grommet opening in tank bottom. Fig. II.


Machine is equipped with a height adjustment knob to raise and lower pressure of brush on floor. Turn clockwise for less brush pressure, counter-clockwise for more brush pressure.

There is also a height indicator located directly behind the height adjustment knob. The indicator has three (3) colors on it to gauge height quickly. See Fig. III.

White • High Orange • Medium Black • Low

To adjust elevation of handle, use the release lever located on the right side of the machine near bottom of tank (standing behind the machine). Three (3) positions. Fig. III.

For your protection, floor brush will not operate in upright position even though vacuum may be on. This prevents damage to floor while using pull-out vacuum hose.



## NOTICE

There is an optional set of brush bearing holders available for your Model 1600. When the bristle length of the brush has worn down approximately 3/16 to 1/4 of an inch, the bearing blocks should be changed from the original set assembled in the machine to the optional set. The additional set, will lower the brush 1/4 of an inch closer to the floor for extra brush life. The part number for the bearing block is 829060.

To replace the bearing block holders remove the four screws which hold the brush plate in place and pull the brush out of the base. The drive pulley will have to be removed from the drive end to disassemble the bearing block. Next pull the bearing blocks off each bearing and assemble the new ones. Now reassemble the remaining parts in reverse order that they were disassembled. The brush should be 1/4 of an inch closer to the floor after assembly has been completed. These extra bearing block holders will allow you to get twice the life from each brush. When a new brush is assembled in the machine, the original bearing block holders should again be put back in place of the optional set which had previously been assembled to the machine, to give proper brush height.


#### ITEMS TO CHECK


<sup>\*</sup>Make sure the hose and stand pipe into the dust bag is clear and unobstructed.

<sup>\*</sup>If your vacuum is not picking up properly, check hose and pipe immediately.

<sup>\*</sup>Be especially careful in vacuuming a new carpet, as it will have a lot of loose pile and the bag will fill quickly.

<sup>\*</sup>Keep brush clean of hair and string.






