




## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS MODEL #807010 BRAKE DRUM CLEANER WITH GLOVES (U.S. PATENT NO. 4,712,270) AND

### MODEL #C80315 - 15 GALLON ASBESTOS RECOVERY VACUUM

Assemble the brake drum stand according to diagram enclosed in carton. Attach brake drum hood assembly onto the adjustable arm so the aperture opening is over the center of the wheel bracket.

The hood assembly is mounted on the cleaner stand with two bungee cords pulled over the top and fastened to the plate. The vacuum hose will be attached to the tube on the hood on the underside of the adjustable arm.

With the hood assembly elevated to about 30" in height, the asbestos recovery vacuum can be placed on the brake drum stand and transported as a unit.

The brake drum assembly hood #807010 is equipped with two heavy-duty rubber gloves sewn into the unit. This will enable the operator to use a hammer or other tools to help dislodge the brake drum when necessary.

A quick coupler air hose is connected to the air jet at the back of the hood assembly. Do not connect the air hose until you are ready to use it. The hood assembly is adjustable to the working elevation from ground level to 60" high.

After removing the wheel from the automobile, roll the stand and hood assembly up to the brake unit on which you will be working. Remove the vacuum from the stand and roll it about 5 feet away. Attach the vacuum hose to the inlet on the hood.

Elevate the hood assembly to center the brake unit. Place onto the plate inside the hood assembly all the tools you may need to remove the brake drum. Plug in the vacuum electric cord and turn on vacuum.

Loosen the bungee cord around the aperture opening to its fullest opening, then roll the stand in toward the brake assembly until it is centered and inside the hood. Draw the bungee cord as much as possible to close the aperture opening. Hook the bungee cord to one of the holes in the frame base.

Insert your hands into gloves and remove the brake drum for the brake assembly. Place the brake drum flat on the base of the hood. Connect the air pressure line to the air jet in the hood assembly and blow the dust from the brake assembly and the brake drum. Using a circular motion, blow the dust that may be left around the inside of the hood itself, then blow out the brake assembly again to be sure you have removed all traces of dust. This should take about two minutes. Maximum air pressure 50 PSI through 1/4" - 3/8" air line

Disconnect the air hose, release the bungee hooks from the stand, open the aperture around the brake assembly, and pull back the stand. Turn off the vacuum. Remove brake drum from hood assembly and place it on your worktable. Proceed with brake shoe relining.

The collector bag in your vacuum will hold approximately six gallons of dry bulk material. This could mean as many as 200 brake jobs before it needs to be cleaned out. To check the efficiency of your vacuum, disconnect the hose from the tank. Turn on the vacuum. Completely choke off the hose intake and listen to the motor noise. When the motor noise increases, the vacuum is operating efficiently. When the motor noise does not increase, it is time to release the collector bag and filters.
